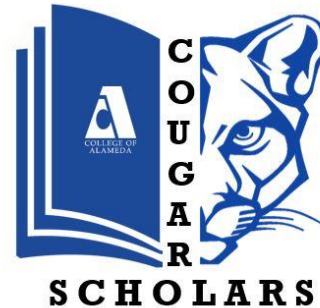


College of Alameda (COA) Promise Scholarship

What is the College of Alameda Promise Scholarship?

Alameda Promise is one of the CoA Cougar Scholars promise programs that provides a pathway for eligible Alameda high school graduates to attend CoA for one year without paying enrollment or other fees (based on 12 units/semester plus other fees).

The COA Promise provides students with intensive academic support, college transfer assistance, priority registration, as well as a book stipend.



What are the goals of the College of Alameda Promise Scholarship?

The College of Alameda Promise aims to:

- Increase the percentage of high school graduates in the city of Alameda entering college
- Strengthen students' access to career pathways and preparation to join the workforce in Alameda and surrounding areas
- Deepen the connection between College of Alameda and its home community

Am I Eligible? Interested Applicants Must:

- Follow the PCCD Steps to Success for new students
- Enroll in 12 units per semester at College of Alameda
- Graduate from ASTI, Encinal, Alameda, or Island high schools
- First-time college student
- Submit a FAFSA or Cal Dream Act application and include COA (006720)
- Attend a Mandatory Cougar Scholars Orientation
