Faculty have access to a variety of LTIs in Canvas. An **LTI** (Learning Tool Interoperability) is simply a technical term for an "app" or **external tool** seamlessly integrated in Canvas. Check out some new and popular LTIs below.

1 NameCoach

Name Coach allows students to record themselves saying their own name, and their gender pronoun, allowing you to know exactly how they want to be addressed. [NameCoach Quick Start Guide](#)
